Broken Hill



Broken Hill is the location of a post conference tour highlighting the significant history and heritage of this iconic outback mining city. Broken Hill has a special place in the imagination of Australians. It was included on the National Heritage List in 2015, the first and only city to be included on this list. It has been the setting for movies and novels and the home of distinctive Australian art movements, all in a unique nineteenth century city.

The theme for this tour will be *“Outback and Beyond” - The Future of Historic Towns and Industrial Heritage - Broken Hill, A Case Study in Heritage Management.*
